Ruthin School's academic success continues 2011 results are the best ever

A Level

This year's cohort of 30 students in Upper Sixth, achieved outstanding results with the percentage of A* and A grades at 61% and the A* to B grades jumping by nearly 10% to 83%. Just under 30% of all grades were at A* level.

We were ranked 31 in the Times (2010 we were 49), which is the league table that looks at only A* and A grades.

Points per candidate was 534.29 – placing us at position 14 out of all schools in the UK and position 4 when just looking at coeducational boarding schools. The only coeducational boarding schools getting better A Level results than Ruthin were Concord College, Shropshire, Caterham School, Surrey and Leicester Grammar School.

These results show the continued academic success of the School, which over the past two years has seen its A Level results dramatically rise. We are now the school with the best A Level results in Wales.

Students now tend to apply for the top ranking universities, which require high grades. Students that obtained A* grades in one more subject gained entry to the following universities to study their chosen course:
