English Teaching

English is taught in three separate sessions. Session one concentrates on traditional techniques of grammar, use of English and vocabulary building, using textbooks. The second session is to help students develop their reading, writing, listening and speaking skills. Session three gives a lighter part to the day, motivating students by encouraging them to study two subjects from a range of options that have particular interest to them. The choice of subjects will vary from year to year, but could include football, fashion, camping, advertising, dance, drama, music, art and photography.

The teaching is provided by qualified native English teachers.

The maximum class size is 10.

Activities

Activities take place each afternoon, with full-day excursions on Saturday's.

The weekday activities can include:

Cinema, BBQ, Treasure Hunt, Team games, Shopping, Arts and Crafts, Fitness, Basket-ball, Ice-skating, Rounders, Local visits, Bowling, Adventure trail, Chester, Museums, Football, Tennis, Badminton, Swimming

The full-day excursions include trips to places further away – including London, Manchester, Liverpool, Alton Towers, Oxford, Stratford, and York.

How to Apply

Complete the Summer Course application form and send it to the School by post, fax or email.

The full fees are due six weeks before the course begins. In order for a student to secure a place on the course, £350 should be paid when booking.

Payment can be made by either sending a cheque/bankers draft to the School, or by transferring monies directly into the School bank account. Parents are responsible for all bank charges.
